The legal basis is § 17 Niedersächsisches Hochschulgesetz (NHG)<sup>1</sup>, § 3 Niedersächsisches Datenschutzgesetz (NDSG)<sup>2</sup>, § 5 Rules Governing the Use of the Hannover Medical School Library <sup>3</sup>, in case of use of joint services across locations and institutions your consent and Art. 6 para. 1 a) EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)<sup>4</sup>

When using **local services**, the partner libraries of the **Cooperation of Hannover's Scientific Libraries** (HOBSY) have access to your personal data for the provision of joint services across locations and institutions. If you order media from other libraries via interlibrary loan, your data will be transmitted to the owning library.

The data will be stored for the duration of your use of the services of this library. If you no longer wish to use the library services and the library has no further claims against you for the return of media, payment of fees or any other legal reason, we will delete your data upon request. If you have not used the services of this library for more than two years, your data will be deleted.

## Your rights:5

You have the right to obtain information about the data stored in this library at any time, as well as on rectification or erasure or on restriction of processing or -as far as the processing is based on your consent - a right of revocation, if necessary a right of objection as well as the right of data portability. Complaints may be lodged with the above-mentioned supervisory authority.
