Class II: RCT that lacks one or two additional features (a-d); Cohort study that matches patients based on baseline characteristics and meets additional criteria (b-d); masked or objective outcome assessment
Class III: Controlled studies (including external controls such as well-defined natural history cohorts); description of a major confounding difference between treatment groups that could affect outcome; outcome assessment performed by someone who is not on the treatment team
Class IV: not meeting Class I-III
