18 Biobank Sites are part of the German Biobank Alliance (GBA) and build the network



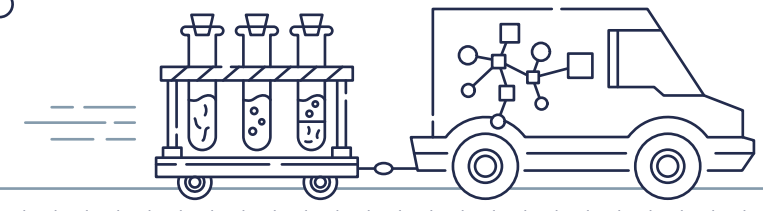
14 Quality-certified or accredited biobank sites according to official standards
