Fee regulation

European Master of Science in Midwifery

Department of Obstetrics, Gynaecology and Reproductive Medicine

as per 12 June 2019

In accordance with the regulations of the Law of higher education for Lower Saxony, as amended on December 18, 2018, the Hannover Medical School (MHH) has issued the following fee regulation for the European Master of Science in Midwifery on 12 June 2019:

§ 1 Semester and tuition fees

The European Master of Science in Midwifery is billable. Students of this master's programme are obliged to defray semester fees (§ 2) and module fees (§ 3).

§ 2 Semester fees

Semester fees consist of administrative costs, student union fees, student service fees, and tuition fees. These fees must be paid by the students within the matriculation and re-registration deadlines for the respective summer and winter semester. Deadlines and total fees will be detailed to the students in a timely manner by the MHH.

§ 3 Module fees

(1) For participating in modules at MHH, the MHH charges a fee which must be paid by the student before module start. Students will receive detailed information on the total fee and the deadlines in a timely manner.

(2) The amount depends on the number of ECTS taught in the module (1 ECTS = \in 70).

(3) Re-registration to a module after deregistration according to the study and examination regulations § 12 (1) requires payment of full fees again.

(4) Divergent from § 3 (2), the fee for the Master thesis module is 2.300 \in .

(5) The Master thesis module can be extended up to 12 months. If further teaching units are demanded during the extension period, module fees need to be paid anew: $2.300 \in$ for attending all 12 teaching units, $1.150 \in$ for attending up to 6 teaching units.

(6) Upon repetition of a failed Master thesis, the module fees for the Master thesis module have to be paid anew. (7) Fees for modules that were not started for reasons outside the student's responsibility can be refunded upon request. Claims for fee refundment, with detailed reasons, are to be directed to the programme leader. Module fees of modules that were already started are non-refundable.

§ 4 Implementation

This regulation takes effect the day after its publication.
