Dear applicant,

First of all, thank you very much for your interest in continuing your medical or dentistry studies at Hannover Medical School!

We are very concerned about the situation in Ukraine in general and in particular with respect to what happens in the medical and educational sector.

Since there are no special regulations regarding the admission and recognition of academic achievements for students from Ukraine, we would like to provide you with information on general requirements and the current procedure for foreign applicants (**please use all links embedded below for comprehensive information!**):

- All lectures and courses for medical and dentistry students at Hannover Medical School are held in German language. Therefore, applicants must provide a <u>German language certificate of the</u> <u>competence levels A or A⁺</u> (corresponding to C2).
- If you cannot provide the language certificate required and the EU Council decision "Granting residence for temporary protection" does not apply to you, you may apply for a <u>residence permit in accordance</u> with Section 16(b) <u>AufenthG</u> [(5) 2.] in order to take preparatory language courses.
- 3. There are no language classes offered at MHH. You may check the <u>website of the Leibniz Language</u> <u>Center</u> for German language courses for beginners.
- 4. More language classes are offered by the *Studienkolleg Niedersachsen*. Information on these classes and a link to their website is provided on our <u>website</u> (see FAQ's).
- 5. The HAWK Hildesheim|Göttingen|Holzminden offers **online German intensive courses** for refugees at beginner level. Please check <u>here</u> for detailled information.
- 6. **More information for students from Ukraine** is provided by the <u>German Academic Exchange</u> <u>Service (DAAD</u>). Their Digital Campus supports you with <u>a variety of offers free of charge</u> on your path to studying in Germany.
- 7. <u>Specific information for beginners</u> or on how to apply <u>for a higher semester</u> directly at Hannover Medical School is presented on our website.
- 8. Registration for the **PJ (practical year)** is only possible if the 2nd state examination has been passed according to German law or has been recognized as an adequate achievement and the graduate is enrolled as a student at a German university, which in turn requires proof of the above-mentioned German language skills.
