Dieter Haffner has published more than 350 original scientific articles, reviews, editorials and book chapters (h-index, 68). His main interests are the mechanistic/genetic exploration of kidney diseases (e.g. X-linked hypophosphatemia, hereditary cystic kidney disease, cystinosis, and renal malformations (CAKUT)), and mineral and bone disorders in children with kidney diseases. He has led, or been heavily involved in, several randomized controlled clinical trials, patient registries, and 20 national, European, and international Clinical Practice Guidelines (AWMF, ESPN, ERKNet, GPN and IPNA).
