

Reporting period 2024



KKS Network: Cooperation of local competence hubs for quality-oriented clinical research with currently **28 members at academic institutions** and over **1,200 specialists** from relevant areas of expertise.



In 2024, members of the KKS Network were substantially* involved in **1,125 clinical studies** and supported **90 registries** with currently more than **100,000 documented patients**.
